A-Level Results Day Plan Thursday 13th August 2020 **GCSE Results Day Plan Thursday 20th August 2020**

I hope you are all having a lovely summer. This year's results day will undoubtedly look quite different to previous years, however we want to reassure you that we will be here on hand to support you with the information you require to help progress onto the next stage of your education or career.

With current Covid-19 guidelines in place, we have had to amend the normal way in which results are collected, to keep in line with social distancing requirements. The details of this will be set out below, as well as other pertinent information that you may find useful on the actual day.

Initially we would like to invite all of you to come and collect your results on Thursday 13th August for A-level and Thursday 20th August for GCSE, however we fully understand that for some of you this may not be practical or safe to do so.

Students wishing to collect results in person

We will be operating an appointment system, this allows different entry and exit points in line with current government guidelines. Please email Mrs Tomlinson (Exams Officer) etomlinson@sexey.somerset.sch.uk selecting a time slot to come onto the school site to collect your results. The times available are:-

9:30 to 10am
10:30 to 11am
11:30 to 12 noon

These slots are the time that you can enter the site, and we ask that you leave by the end of your allocated slot. This is to ensure we can accommodate all students and the need to socially distance. Once you have your results and have celebrated with staff and others present, please can you leave the site promptly. We are sorry that we have to ask this but I am sure you appreciate the need for us to keep one another safe and appropriately socially distance. We appreciate that many of you will want to bring family members with you to collect your results; please can we ask you to limit this to two adults each.

Once we have received your email requesting a timeslot you will be emailed 24 hours before the results day to confirm your arrival time and the venue where you can collect your results from as to support social distancing we will be using 2 venues on site.

Students not wishing to collect results in person

If you are not able to collect the results yourself, then you can opt to:

1. Have your results emailed to you, for this; we will use your school email address.
2. Arrange for someone else to collect your results from school on your behalf.

If you are asking another person to collect your results on your behalf then you will need to:

1. Notify Mrs Tomlinson who is collecting your results.
2. Provide the person collect them with a letter giving permission for that person to collect the results.
3. Unless the person is known to Sexey's staff, they will need to bring some form of photographic ID with them.

1. You will be collecting your results in person and request a time slot.
2. You will not be attending the site and would like your results emailed to you.
3. Confirm who will be collecting your results on your behalf.
