

## Sexey's School Uniform Guide Years 7-11

You are recommended to purchase uniform from our official supplier, Stevensons. Any non-branded uniform purchased from alternative suppliers must be the same colour and shade as those available from Stevensons and must meet the requirement of the School Dress Code.

### FAQs

#### ***Can I have items sent to Sexey's School?***

You can arrange delivery of uniform items from Stevensons to your home, or to Sexey's for you to collect during term time.

#### ***Do you have samples of the uniform my child can try on?***

We hope to hold a year 6 induction day in July (details to be confirmed) when Stevensons will visit the school and uniform can be tried on for sizing and purchased. However, there is a comprehensive size guide on the Stevensons website.

#### ***Will you stock some items in Sexey's School?***

Black tights will be available to purchase.

#### ***How should the uniform be worn?***

The uniform dress code is set out in this leaflet.

#### ***Should uniform be clearly marked?***

All linen and clothing must be marked with embroidered name tapes – sewn in, not ironed. These need to be sewn securely on skirts, trousers, jumpers, blazers, personal/casual clothing and pants (for boarders), corner of hem of towels. Shoes and trainers must also be named.

- School maroon polo shirt (worn tucked in)
- School kilt (worn on or below the knee)
- Black trousers (formal fit with a crease down centre, no low waist, skin tight drainpipes, slim leg, boot cut or jeans)
- School black long-sleeved V-neck jumper (optional)
- Short black socks or black tights
- Black formal shoes

Uniform is worn during the school day (including examinations) and detentions. Day students wear uniform when travelling to and from school. Boarding students wear uniform for visits into Bruton. Only items listed in the school uniform list are considered legitimate items of uniform and alternative items are not to be worn by students except where the Head, Assistant Heads or Heads of Year have given permission.

## Winter

Blazers are worn during the school day, from leaving home or the boarding house in the morning until you enter again after school.

Concessions are made only:

- in class, **if** the teacher gives permission
- at break and lunchtime in hot weather or while participating in a physical activity

Shirts are worn tucked into trousers or skirts. Collars and cuffs must be fastened. Ties are to be worn and should be done up with the knot covering the top button of the shirt, the broad section outer-most and 4 eagles visible. The tie should be worn at approximately A4 length. A black, school V-neck jumper may be worn in addition under the blazer.

## Summer

Burgundy polo shirts are the designated uniform for the summer term and are worn tucked in. A black, school V-neck jumper may be worn over the top. Blazers are not required in the summer term.

## General Appearance

Students are expected to wear shoes and clothes that are clean and in a reasonable condition such that general appearance is neat and presentable.

The School kilt length must be worn on or below the knee.

Black trousers should be a formal fit with a crease down the centre, no low waist, skin tight drainpipes, slim leg, boot cut or jeans.

Shoes should be plain, smart black leather or simulated leather - boots, trainers, daps (canvas equivalent), platforms or heels are not appropriate footwear for our school site.

Hair should be neat and well-groomed and not styled in any extreme way. Hair colour and style must be appropriate for school and should be of a natural colour. Boys should be clean shaven.

To help with the interpretation:

- Hair which is long (below the collar) may present a health & safety hazard in some lessons. In such instances the student will be required to tie their hair back.
- Extreme style includes unnatural colour, streaks of colour and/or different colour, and/or blocks of colour. Shaven heads – partially or whole including tram lines, unevenness of cut, undercuts *etc.* and hair shorter than grade 2 are not allowed.

Make-up is not permitted with school uniform. Where a student has a skin condition and make-up may be advised on medical grounds parents should contact the Head of Key Stage to discuss the matter and provide medical evidence.

## Jewellery

The following is permitted:

- A plain wrist watch (with a close-fitting strap/bracelet)
- One charity wrist band
- One plain or signet ring
- One small cross or other religious symbol on a plain chain
- One plain gold stud / sleeper earring only in each ear

Students may be required to remove jewellery for health and safety reasons. Parents are requested to ensure body piercings of any nature are not undertaken unless the length of healing time is covered by a school holiday as students will be required to remove any items which do not conform to the school Dress Code. Appropriate kit should be worn for PE and students must ask permission of a teacher to wear games kit in a lesson other than PE (unless this has been arranged in advance by PE staff)
