


Extended Day offer:

- Silver: up to 5 days a week (Breakfast) - £350 a term
- **Gold:** up to 5 days a week* (Breakfast, after school activities, supervision in boarding house and supper. Collection at 7pm Mon-Thurs, 5pm on Fridays) - £870 a term
- **Platinum:** up to 5 days a week* (Breakfast, after school activities, supervision and activities in boarding house, supper and supervised prep. Collection at 9pm Mon-Thurs and 7pm on Fridays) - £1215 a term.

* Please note the earlier collection time of 5pm on the Friday of an Exeat weekend.

How do I book?

For enquiries and bookings please contact admissions@sexeyes.somerset.sch.uk or telephone 01749 814101.

You will be asked to complete and return a contact form, boarding contract and health questionnaire prior to your first booking.

When do I need to book by?

We require places to be booked a minimum of one week prior to attending.

What are the timings and logistics?

Students will register at the KDR by 7.45am. Collection will be at the boarding house and timing depends on your offer level (Gold: 7pm or Platinum: 9pm).

What activities are on offer?

Activities vary on a nightly basis in consultation with the students. They may include dodgeball, swimming, team building exercises, table tennis and prep.

Occasional Boarding at Sexey's

Heard about the benefits of state boarding and curious about giving it a try?

We understand the importance of maintaining a flexible approach to boarding and now offer full time, part-time and occasional boarding at Sexey's, to fit your family's needs.

What is occasional boarding?

Occasional boarding enables a day student to board up to 14 nights per term – either on a regular basis or just occasionally. This might be especially useful when they are involved in an activity which involves an early start or evening rehearsal.

We are happy to care for students to allow them to stay overnight on an agreed number of days each week, as agreed in advance.

How do I apply for occasional boarding?

First of all, you will need to contact Admissions:

admissions@sexkeys.somerset.sch.uk or telephone 01749 814101. You will be asked to complete and return a contact form, boarding contract, T&Cs and health questionnaire prior to confirming your place.

How far in advance do I need to apply?

Occasional boarding will need to be booked at least one week in advance on a first come, first served basis. A student may only stay up to 14 nights a term, except in exceptional circumstances with prior agreement. It will be paid for in advance via Parent Pay. N.B. The fee will be non-refundable if the stay is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to arrival.

What is the cost and what is included?

- Day Student Occasional Boarding (Monday to Thursday rate) - £65 per night
- Day Student Occasional Boarding (Friday, Saturday and Sunday rate) - £76 per night

This includes supervised prep and activities in the boarding houses, dinner and bed with breakfast and lunch the following day.

What will I need to bring?

A small bag of personal possessions and nightwear. Bedding will be provided and laundered by the House.

Where can I find a list of activities?

Boarding House activities vary weekly and include input from the students as well as House Parents.
