Command words AO2 Discuss....	<u>Discuss</u> this statement showing that you have considered more than one point of view (you must refer to religion and belief in your answer). 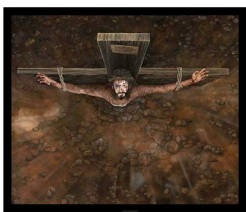

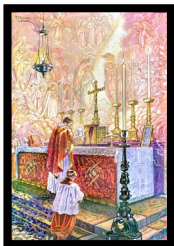
